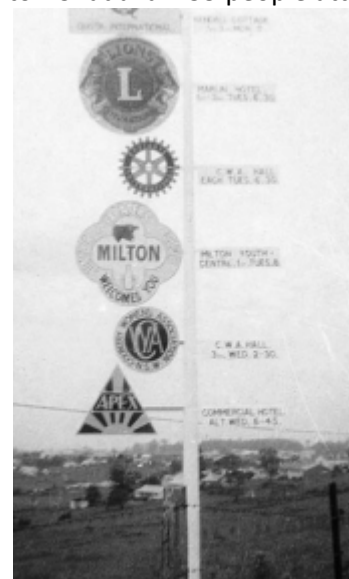

Club History; The RC of Milton Ulladulla's History has been researched, condensed and produced by PDG Werner Pohl. With the exception of the first 8 years when the Club records were maintained by charter member the late PP Ken Kendall.

On March 15th 1960 the inaugural meeting occurred of the provisional Rotary Club at the CWA Hall in Milton, later to be granted a Charter by Rotary International on April 10th 1960.

This Charter was presented by the then District 270 Governor Fred Fischer on June 18th 1960 at a function at the Masonic Hall in Milton and 25 members were inducted into the Rotary Club of Milton Ulladulla. 199 people attended this function.
